On January 2020, the Enabling BiomassTrade Platform, one of the project's most important tools, was launched on the website.

The <u>BiomassTrade Platform</u> is an online venue where biomass producers and biomass processers can meet to exchange currently not valorized organic biomass residues and organic by-products. It allows interested users to search and offer organic biomass residues and by-products, bio-based products as well as services in the different sectors of bioeconomy. The Platform operates EU-wide but aims to connect stakeholders on a regional level to foster the exchange of goods and services on a regional level.

What is more, the BiomassTrade Platofrm:

- Increases biomass availability for the bio-based industry
